How It Works

Volunteers participating in the program will be asked to select a hole on the course as their adopted hole and spend some time (30-45 minutes a day, 2-3 days a week) helping by filling divots with sand, repairing ball marks on the green, picking up broken tees from the tee box areas, raking bunkers and gathering debris and trash from the golf course. If you see an issue on your hole that is beyond the defined scope of work, let us know in the proshop and we will take care of it.

These tasks can be done while you are playing a round (as long as you don't hold up play) or you can coordinate with the pro shop during slower times on the course to get a bucket of sand, borrow a cart (no charge) and head out to your adopted hole.

We also have the Driving Range Tee and Practice Green available for adoption.
